CALL FOR PAPERS

As we know, the new guidelines for resuscitation have been updated, respectively, by American Heart Association (AHA) and European Resuscitation Council (ERC) in November 2015. Treatment strategies are therefore changed obviously. Early resuscitation for achieving adequate organs perfusion is emphasized for shock or cardiac arrest patients. Furthermore, the significance of prehospital and postresuscitative cares is demonstrated to predictably associate with patient survival and neurological outcomes.

Many recurrent studies highlighted the issue regarding the new changes of resuscitation; however, the importance of prehospital and postresuscitative cares was not well addressed. Therefore, we aim to provide an opportunity to widely introduce your related researches. We solicit your high quality, original research articles as well as review articles focusing on the field of emergency and critical care, especially ones about prehospital and postresuscitation care for shock and cardiac arrest.

- ▶ Resuscitation training and educations
