FRANK GLENN TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP 1992

The International Hepato-Biliary-Pancreatic Association invites applications for the above travelling Fellowship. A stipend of \$5000 Dollars U.S. is available to subsidize a young investigator in the field of hepato-biliary and pancreatic disorders. The applicant must be sponsored by a member of the Association. The stipend may be used to support a laboratory project and/or to subsidize travel expenses which are deemed appropriate to the field of investigation. Applicants must be under 40 years of age and should have an established record of at least one or several papers concerning liver, biliary or pancreatic disease.

Applications should be made in writing and should include the following:

1. a copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae;
2. a summary of 1–2 pages of a research protocol describing how the stipend is to be used;
3. a letter of nomination from a member of the IHBPA Association or your Department Chairman.
