The eight ranked survey statements were:

- Q1. The current letters of recommendation are valuable predictors of resident performance.
- Q2. Letters of recommendation offer a realistic way to compare applicants.
- Q3. More letters of recommendation allow for a more accurate assessment of the applicant.
- Q4. Familiarity with the author of the letter strengthens the recommendation.
- Q5. Increasing the objective nature of the letters of recommendation would be valuable in comparing candidates.
- Q6. Non-cognitive (qualitative) measures are important in ranking applicants.
- Q7. Letters of recommendation are valuable resources in assessing an applicant's non-cognitive attributes.
- Q8. A standardized letter of recommendation would improve the overall selection process.
