















## Erratum

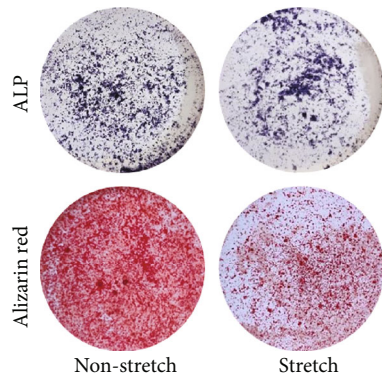
